"THE WORLD OF YESTERDAY" – SEEN THROUGH THE CATASTROPHE OF 1939 (FEELINGS OF THREATENED EUROPE IN THE CULTURE AND LITERATURE OF BULGARIA, UKRAINE, POLAND AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA)

The conference will be held on 9th – 10th October 2025 in the Great Hall of the Institute for Literature (address: 52 Shipchenski Prohod Blvd., block 17, ground floor, Sofia 1113, Bulgaria).

The conference is organised within the framework of the international scientific project "The World of Yesterday" – Seen Through the Catastrophe of 1939 (Feelings of Threatened Europe in the Culture and Literature of Bulgaria, Ukraine, Poland and Czechoslovakia) on the basis of a contract with the National Fund "Scientific Research" No. KΠ-06- H60/2 from 16.11.2021 with additional agreement 2841/27.06.2024.

In view of the theme of the project, we offer you the following thematic fields for work at the conference.

- 1. The instability of the Versailles system of treaties of Europe. Catastrophisms in late artistic and literary avant-gardes (around 1932).
- 2. A ghost is haunting Europe the ghost of totalitarianism. The warnings of great European intellectuals about the impending danger. From the Anschluss of Austria to local military conflicts in Europe. Wounded Spain as a pan-European literary and artistic theme. The figures of Don Quixote and Cassandra as European symbols. The overgrown aggressive nationalisms and their essayistic and philosophical visions (1935 1936).

- 3. The war invades the worlds of European man. Tragically divided Europe. The epic of the war, bombardment, camps, ghettos, uprisings, the Holocaust, the resistance, the European solidarity. The emigrants from the USA speak (1939 1944).
- 4. The triumphalism of the victors, but also the fate of the divided Europe (1945).
